Dear Water System Customer:

The Water Department will be replacing all the water meters in the system because the majority of the existing meters are forty years old, and many have stopped operating. This replacement will include installation of new pressure regulators and backflow prevention valves. The Town has contracted this work to be done by E.J. Prescott and their installation crew, Saks Metering.

The project is due to start on May 28, 2015. The Saks installers will be going house to house to set up appointments and/or verify a time to do the work. They will be wearing photo ID tags, and drive vehicles identifying them as Saks Metering. If you are not home, they will leave a door hanger with all the information you will need to call and set up an appointment. Apartment owners, please discuss this with your tenants, and if they get a door hanger, have them contact you so you can call Saks Metering to confirm and arrange the installation time.

Each installation will vary, but should take about an hour. During this time, you will not have water, so please plan accordingly. The crew will begin installing meters on Monday, June 1, 2015, and work Monday through Saturday from 8:00 A.M. – 6:00 P.M. With cooperation from property owners, they expect to have all the meters installed in one month.

If you wish to schedule early, you may call 877-583-7257 after May 11, 2015 between 8 A.M. and 6 P.M. This may allow you to secure an appointment time better suited to your schedule.
